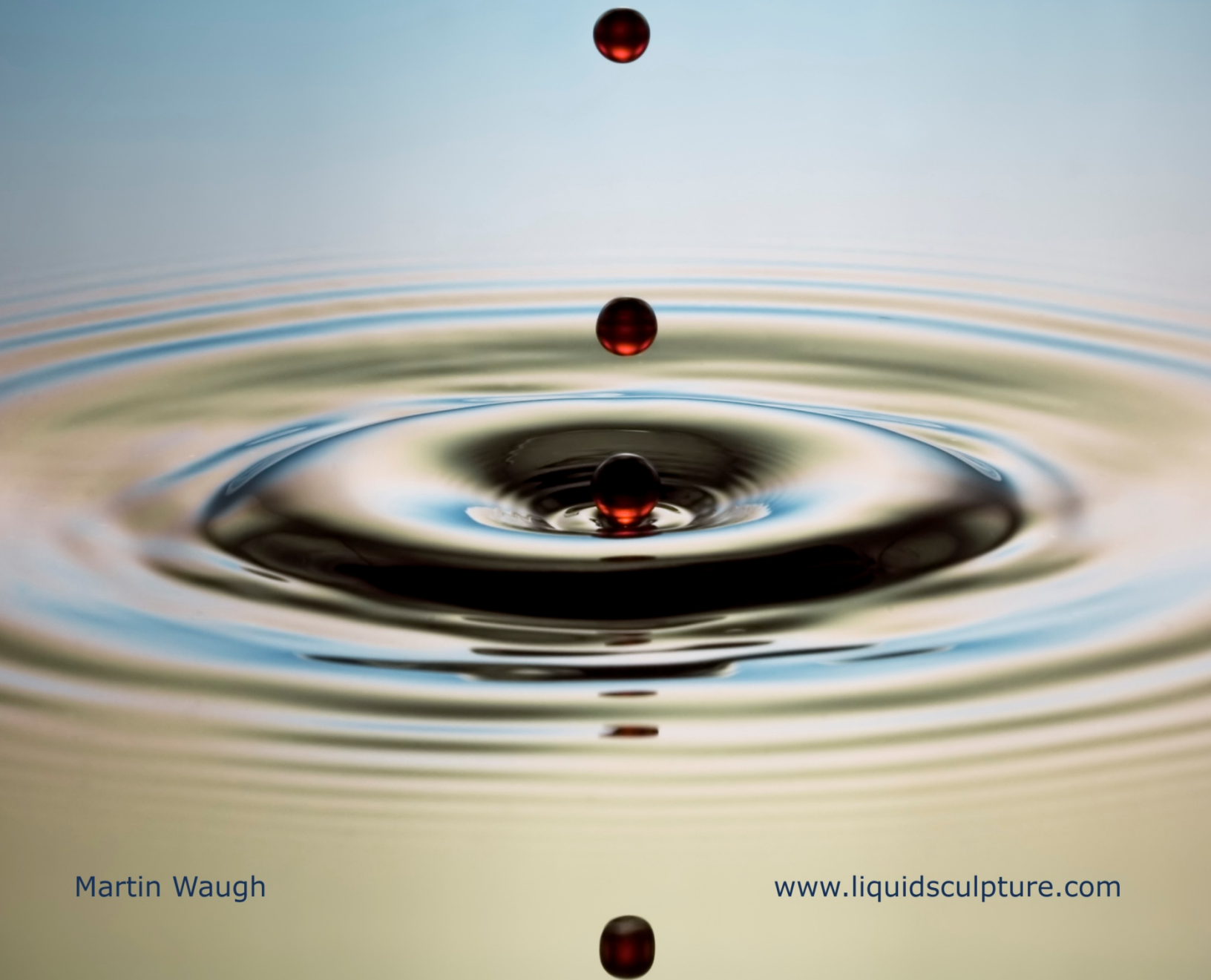


# *Liquid Sculpture*

Combining art and science to capture nature's infinite beauty



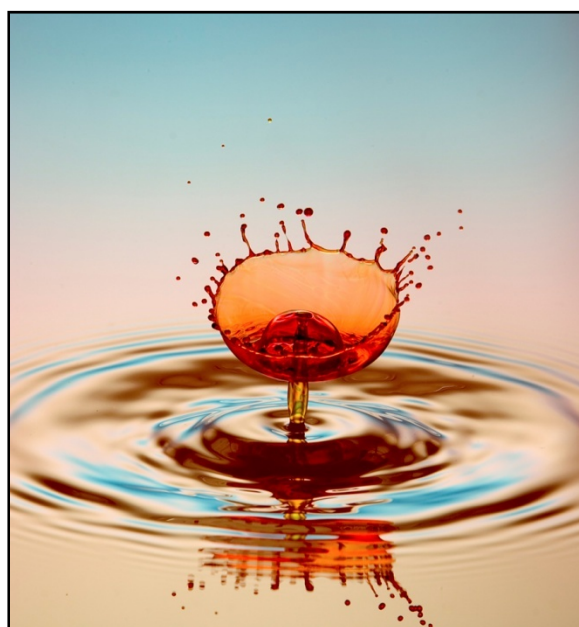
## Water

We are drawn to water. From our primordial beginnings and prenatal environment to child's play in bathtubs and sprinklers, liquids incite our senses and imagination. The draw is universal, as we all share these origins.

Water plays a prominent role in all cultures. From baptism to Buddhist water offerings, it is a symbol of spirituality and cleanliness. The Druids believed that rivers, lakes and wells were all dwelling places to the supernatural creatures. In Islam, water symbolizes God's benevolence. Water is believed to have spiritually cleansing powers in Hinduism.

Liquid Sculpture images are Rorschach figures. People see many different scenes in the figures. A palm tree on an island, a woman with an umbrella, a dancer, a grumpy old man - the pictures are a playground for the imagination.

Martin Waugh captures the intriguing and seductive shapes of liquids in motion. The resulting images captivate the viewer in a world of rich color, smooth curves, and simple lines. Using his exclusive techniques, Martin creates the most detailed, colorful, and artistic liquid images to date.



## Treasure Island Hotel

### Client Spotlight

In 2006, MGM/Mirage remodeled the Wet Spa at the Treasure Island hotel. The designers chose a water theme, using wave-shaped walls and carpet, wavy glass, and a blue/green palette.

When they found Martin's work, they knew they wanted to use his art for the decor. They chose 18 large prints in brushed stainless steel frames to display throughout the facility. The images simultaneously convey relaxation and invigoration - a perfect day at the spa.

The Treasure Island advertising team then commissioned Martin to create six custom images for brochures and print ads. Each image signifies one of the major services that the spa offers: hair salon, men's and women's spa, pedicures, and facials. Martin used photography and post-production editing to create the evocative liquid shapes.



## Prints

All standard prints are open edition and are produced using state of the art digital imaging equipment. A thin laminate adds protection from ultraviolet light and handling. The result is highly detailed, richly colored, and very durable prints.

Standard sizes are (in inches) 11x14, 20x24, 24x32, and 32x48. Other sizes are available on request. Discounts are given to agencies.

Prints are normally sold unframed, though we can provide frames as well.
